6	<b>The trip:</b> Read the story again. Where do Jessica and Sarah start their holiday? Then where do they go? 							
7	<b>Character profile:</b> Fill in the profile for the person of your choice.							
8	<b>Sarah's bag:</b> Jessica runs after Michael but she doesn't take Sarah's bag (page 7). What does Sarah say to Jessica? Is she angry with her? Would you be angry if you were Sarah?							
9	<b>Postcard:</b> Find pictures of New Zealand. You are Michael. Make and write a postcard to your mother and father. You can use craft stuff (Bastelmaterial).

5	<b>Review:</b> Do you like the book? Why /Why not?	

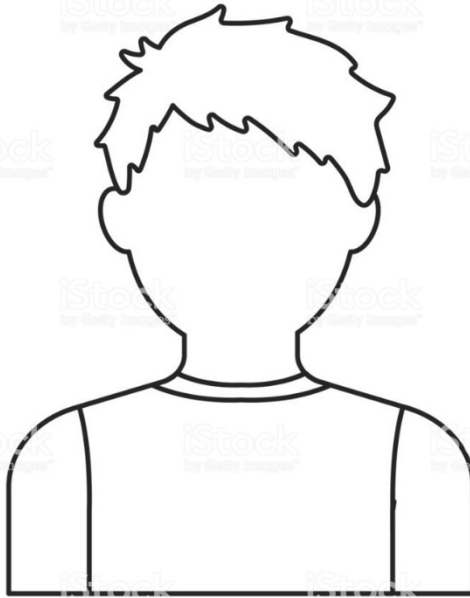

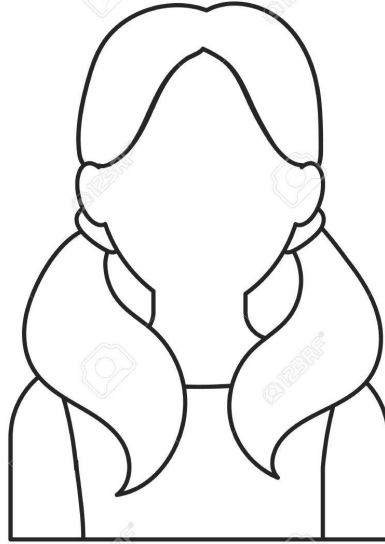
